

266: In reading the new information posted on FOCl, I interpret that if a LLC is solely owned and its parent company has a favorable FOCl determination letter dated less than 5 years ago, than the LLC does not need to submit the additional SF328, OODEP, and RFI forms. Is this correct?

Answer: No. The new LLC is a separate company that must have its own determination. While the favorable FOCl determination of the parent company might speed the process, the forms noted above as well as all other information required of an LLC must be submitted to obtain a determination on the new LLC. Reminder to all offerors: Unless already submitted, information must also be submitted on the parent company as specified in the previously issued instructions and solicitation.
