

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the proposal due date and provide other revisions to the RFP.

1. Reference Section B, Clause B.1.8 “Authorization Of Transition Costs Under The Contract”, the second paragraph is revised as follows:

From: “Contract transition is the period of time between award of the contract and the date the contractor assumes full responsibility, currently anticipated to be August 16, 2004.”

To: “Contract transition is the period of time between award of the contract and the date the contractor assumes full responsibility, currently anticipated to be October 1, 2004.”

2. Reference Section C.2.3.2.2, “Work to be Performed”, the following paragraphs are revised as follows:

a. Paragraph a) is revised:

From: “Receive an additional 2,800 DUF₆ cylinders from East Tennessee Technology Park.”

To: “Receive an additional 5,951 DUF₆ cylinders from East Tennessee Technology Park.”

b. Paragraph b), the first sentence is revised:

From: “Perform surveillance and maintenance on all (estimated 19,000 existing and additional 2,800 cylinders) DUF₆ cylinders and ensure storage requirements are consistent with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Director’s Final Findings and Orders, and applicable requirements of the Portsmouth Safety Analysis Report.”

To: “Perform surveillance and maintenance on all (estimated 19,287 existing cylinder inventory; plus 2,900 cylinders anticipated to be received during FY04 and 3, 051 cylinders anticipated to be received during FY05 for an estimated total of 25,238 cylinders) DUF₆ cylinders and ensure storage requirements are consistent with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Director’s Final Findings and Orders, and applicable requirements of the Portsmouth Safety Analysis Report.”

3. Reference Section C.2.7.9, “Computer/Radio/Telephones”, the first sentence is revised as follows:

From: “A Local Area Network (LAN) and a Wide Area Network (WAN) configured to allow multiple users will be provided for the Remediation Contractor’s use at Paducah via a T-1 line.”

To: “A Local Area Network (LAN) and a Wide Area Network (WAN) configured to allow multiple users will be provided for the Remediation Contractor’s use at Portsmouth via a T-1 line.”

4. Reference Section L.18(j)(1), the second sentence is revised as follows:

From: “For the purposes of cost proposal preparation the offeror shall assume a 45 calendar day transition period.”

To: “For the purposes of cost proposal preparation the offeror shall assume a 35 calendar day transition period.”

5. Reference Section L.18(l), the second sentence is revised as follows:

From: “For purposes of the proposal, offerors shall assume the award will be made on July 2, 2004.”

To: “For purposes of the proposal, offerors shall assume the award will be made on August 26, 2004.”

6. Reference Section L.19, the first sentence is revised as follows:

From: “All proposals must be received at the following address by 4:00 PM EST, **March 16, 2004.**”

To: “All proposals must be received at the following address by 4:00 PM EST, **March 30, 2004.**”

7. Reference Section L.21, the first sentence is revised as follows:

From: “Offerors and interested parties may submit questions regarding this solicitation until two weeks before the RFP closes via e-mail to:”

To: “Offerors and interested parties may submit questions regarding this solicitation until 4:00 PM EST, March 5, 2004 via e-mail to:”
